# 8. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

There is a Central Library with more than 16000 books which serves all the institutions at the Campus. The Library is well furnished with books on various subjects, journals, reference books and magazines.

Additionally CoC-SF also established its own Commerce Library with more than 2300 professional books on Business and Commerce.

#### 11. COMPUTER LABS

Sultana Foundation has four, well equipped Computer Labs with about 60 latest PCs. Internet and Multimedia facilities as Audio Visual Aids are also used as modern tools in teaching methodology.

#### 12. HEALTH CARE

A primary health care unit also functions at the Campus. Patients are facilitated by experienced male and female Doctors and visiting consultants. These Doctors are supported by X-ray, test labs and adequate Paramedical staff. The treatment is free as it is a part of welfare programme of Sultana Foundation.



#### 13. CAFETERIA

Two Cafeterias are functioning at the Campus for male and female students. Students can enjoy meals, tea, cold drinks and snacks etc. The College management supervises cafeteria to ensure good quality of service and food.


# 14. MASJID
